ACP POSITION & POLICY STATEMENT

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Speakers at ACP Sponsored Educational Activities

The purpose of the American College of Phlebology (ACP), as stated in its bylaws, is for the advancement of the art and science of phlebology. The ACP provides a forum for physicians and healthcare professionals interested in venous diseases. It seeks to improve the understanding of the diagnosis and treatment of venous diseases by physicians and seeks to improve the delivery of care of venous diseases to the public. The ACP is a non-profit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and public purposes.

The ACP plans and programs educational activities each year that are developed with the purpose of sharing research, scientific knowledge, and expertise in all areas of the diagnosis and treatment of venous diseases.

Speakers are selected on the basis of their known expertise in the field of phlebology and their willingness to share that expertise with those who attend.
